Students answer IELTS speaking part one exam questions about social norms.

Lesson 8. Social Norms. Part 2

Students give their response to an IELTS speaking part two exam question about a special meal or food that is important in their culture.

Students will practise IELTS Speaking part one questions covering the topics they have been taught to date.
